




Goodwill Impacts Lives In DuPage County!

Community Engagement: Acts of Goodwill in DuPage County



Goodwill believes in the Power of Work and the Power of the Whole community working together. We remain committed to providing training, employment and supportive services where the need is greatest.

To celebrate our Centennial, 247 Goodwill employees created over 100 Acts of Goodwill across the communities where we operate. Our employee volunteers engaged with community partners to help address barriers to work for job seekers and to support the workforce of the future. Employee volunteers served individuals facing barriers to work at 43 partner organizations across our territory.



In 2019, managers from select Goodwill Store & Donation Centers in the Chicago metropolitan area volunteered to help students conduct mock interviews at the [College of DuPage](#), for members of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing community. The mock interviews offered a perfect opportunity for the students to practice their interpreting skills and it also gave members of the Deaf and Hard of Hearing community the ability to practice for their own job interviews. This volunteer experience also helped our store managers because it provided them an opportunity to learn how to support an employee who might be Deaf or Hard of Hearing.
